- Services are available for up to 90 consecutive days
- Emergency assistance and medical evacuation services:
 - Identity theft assistance when traveling
 - Telephonic interpretation services
 - Medical professional locator services
 - Coordination of pre-hospital assistance
 - Repatriation of mortal remains
 - Arrange for transport of traveling companion
 - Transport to nearest appropriate medical facility or home if medically necessary
 - Return of dependent children and rental vehicle; coordination of pet return
 - Assistance replacing lost or stolen luggage, medication, or other critical items
- Security evacuation services including transport to the nearest safe area
